A Profile of the College

The year 1984 of the last century was an eventful year and epoch in making the history of Garoimari and its neighbouring areas. At that time, a handful of people got knowledge of literacy, the light of higher education, by and large, disappeared in the area. It was almost beyond the dream of generating higher educated people from a man-power-producing industry establishing in Garoimari area. A few among all could realise the need of higher education. Among them, we must take the name of some personalities like Omor Ali Sarkar (the founder president of Managing Committee), Abdul Hakim (the founder Secretary) and many others who endeavoured their relentless effort in establishing the College. Abdur Rahman Khan as well as Abdul Qayyum Al-Aman played an active and pioneering role in shaping and moulding the foundation of the College. Besides, the contribution of all the MLAs of Chhaygaon Constituency since 1980 till date has not been less memorable for their all kinds of assistance. Garoimari is mostly dominated by the minority Muslims dependent basically on agrarian economy, the people of the area extended spontaneous support to establish a College. The mission of the College was to spread the ray of higher education by breaking the barrier of darkness among the rural people.

In the year 1984 on an auspicious day, the dream turns into reality with the establishment of the higher educational institution named F.A. Ahmed College. The College is named in memory of Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed, an Assamese son who decorated the sovereign chair of India during the period 1974 to 1977. It is the only higher educational institution that has been imparting education in the Degree Classes (Arts) since its inception.

Mr Habibur Rahman rendered his service as Principal of the College till his retirement on 31st December, 2014. The College was provincialized by the State Government of Assam w.e.f. 01/01/2013 but the post of the principal was not-provincialised. It will always remain in-compensatory to him who offers about 24 years' prolonged service. After his departure, Abdul Awal Sahab has taken the charge of the Principal.

The college has its vast and sprawling campus covering an area 3.34 hectares (25 *bighas*) of land and the serene atmosphere of the college attracts one and all. The co-educational Arts Degree College which had a humble beginning with 161 students and 10 faculties at the time of its establishment. At present, about 968 number of students have been enrolled and facilitated for higher education. The teaching component comprises 10 faculties. The student feedback system has been introduced to remove the deficiency in the course and enhancement of teaching quality.

The college has traversed a long distance since its inception. It has produced a large number of brilliant students into university and many of them are well placed in social as well as political life. The college is lagging behind in certain infrastructural facilities like incomplete Boundary Wall, separate Departmental facilities for each subject, well equipped library facilities etc. which are very urgent for the healthy environment of the College.

The College at a Glance:

- F.A. Ahmed College was established in 1984.
- The publication of College magazine named “BALICHANDA” was started in 1993.
- The College was affiliated to Gauhati University in 1996-97.
- Examination centre in the College was initiated in 1997.
- The College was accorded Government Concurrence in 1999.
- The College was Provincialised by the State Government of Assam w.e.f. 01-01-2013.
- IQAC was introduced in 2013.
- The College got the status of 2(F) & 12(B), UGC in 2014.
- The Study Centre of KKHSOU was initiated in 2007.
- A Girls’ Hostel (Assam Type) is constructed in 2015. A grant of Rs. 80 lakhs is sanctioned by the UGC for another Women’s Hostel, which is under construction.
- A fund of Rs. 10 lakhs for the development of Library was sanctioned by the Minority Development Board of Assam in 2015 which is utilised in purchasing books and infrastructural development of the library.
- A Multi-Purpose Community Hall is completed in 2018.
- Boundary Wall of the College is under construction.
- NSS Cell is formed in 2018.
- D.El.Ed. Study Centre is introduced in 2018.
- ACR building of around Rs. 17 Lac is under construction.

Mission & Vision:

The College aims at preparing the students as democratic, competitive & productive. Moreover, the college targets to generate manpower from the marginalised and vulnerable section of the society to minimize the inequalities and the quality difference among various classes of the people.

Objectives:

The College emphasises on the following prime Objectives:

- ❖ To impart quality higher education in order to prepare the students to overcome the challenges they face in their real life situation.
To democratise and liberalise the thought of the youths for maintaining a cordial nexus with foreign nations.

4. Internal Evaluation would be based on two Sessional Examinations, Home Assignment, Departmental Seminar and Library Works in each Semester. External Evaluation would be through a Final Examination at the end of each Semester.
5. The pass mark is 30% for theory and 40% for practical. Students must pass in both internal as well as external examination separately.
6. A student who either couldn't appear or failed in any Semester will be allowed to clear the same as follows;
 - i) 1st Semester with regular 3rd Semester.
 - ii) 2nd Semester with regular 4th Semester.
 - iii) 3rd Semester with regular 5th Semester.
 - iv) 4th Semester with regular 5th Semester.
7. A student may be allowed to repeat anyone of the theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Semesters and he/she may be allowed for the betterment of marks in one paper in the 5th Semester only if he/she secures less than 45% marks in that paper.
8. A student must clear all the Semesters within five years period from the date of admission to the 1st Semester course. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular Semester. There is no scope for student to appear as a private candidate.
9. Anything not included above should be resolved as per Gauhati University Rules.

COURSE AND COMBINATION OF THE SUBJECTS

F.A. Ahmed College is an Arts Degree College imparting Bachelor three years Degree Course (six semesters). A student is required to take two compulsory subjects in I, II, III and IV Semesters. Along with the compulsory subjects, a student is required to take two elective subjects for B.A. general course and for Major, a student is required to take a Major subject and one elective subject respectively. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(a) Issue of Application Form:

The candidates seeking admission at F.A. Ahmed College have to apply in a prescribed application form. The admission form along with prospectus may be collected in person from the College office paying Rs.150/- (Rupees One Hundred and Fifty Only) either through cash or crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of Principal, F.A. Ahmed College, Garoimari payable at Assam Gramin Bikash Bank, Goroimari.

(b) Submission of Application:

- (i) Application form completed in all regards is to be submitted to the College office during the College hours. No application form will be accepted after the last date of submission. Application forms sent by post or courier must reach the College on or before the last date of submission. The College shall not take any responsibility for postal delay if any.
- (ii) The application form must be submitted along with true copies of mark sheet and certificate of the last qualifying examination and caste certificates wherever necessary.
- (c) Admission will be on the basis of merit.
- (d) Admission Process would be conducted through cashless transaction.
- (e) Reservation of Seats:
 - (i) Seats are reserved as per Govt. Norms for SC, ST, OBC and MOBC candidates.
 - (ii) Seats are reserved for physically challenged and the candidates having Extra-curricular Activities

DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED IN ORIGINAL AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- (i) Original mark sheet and certificate of the last qualifying examinations.
- (ii) Certificate from the Head of the Institute last attended.
- (iii) Gap certificate whenever necessary has to be issued by a Gazetted Officer/Head of the Institute last attended. Gap will not be accepted exceeding two years.
- (iv) Two copies of passport size photographs.
- (v) Original caste certificate when admission is sought against caste quota.
- (vi) Original supporting documents for Extra-curricular Activities.
- (vii) Original documents issued by the competent authority in case of physically challenged candidates.
- (viii) Every candidate would have to produce a photograph of planting a new sapling with himself/herself.

Procedure for Major Selection:

For admission in the 1st Semester major classes, departments have their own selection procedures. After getting admission in the College, the head of the respective Department is to be met to know about the procedures of selection.

Intake capacity for major subjects will be decided by the respective Departments:

N.B. :

- (i) Major classes of all Departments will start from the date which will be announced in the notice board by the authority.
- (ii) According to latest Gauhati University guidelines, a student offering major in language (other than the classics) is allowed to take MIL/Alt. English of the same language.
- (iii) A student taking major in Assamese.
- (iv) Subject combination of Economics/History, Hindi/Philosophy and Mathematics/ASL are not allowed.

Students' Code of Conduct:

- (i) Use of Mobile Phone within the College premises is strictly prohibited.
- (ii) It is obligatory for all the students to use the standard prescribed College uniform. Students not wearing proper uniform wouldn't be allowed to enter into the College campus. Disciplinary action may be taken in case of failing the same. Students are suggested to follow "*Photograph of Students in College Uniform*".
- (iii) Students must carry their College Identity Card at all times inside the College campus. In case of loss or damage, he/she should inform the College authority immediately to have next copy of the same.
- (iv) Student must be regular and punctual in attending classes. It is to be noted that at least 75% attendance is required for appearing in any final examinations.
- (v) Loitering in the corridor and veranda are not permitted.
- (vi) Smoking and chewing tobacco is strictly prohibited inside the College campus.
- (vii) Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse for their non-observance.
- (viii) Ragging in any form inside the College is strictly prohibited. Students involved in such activities may be punished severely as per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- (ix) College properties must be used with utmost care.
- (x) Students must attend in all the festivals, functions and students related meetings.

THE STUDENTS' WELFARE & UTILITY SERVICES

The College bears a 'Student's Aid Fund' that provides financial help to economically backward and meritorious students. Applications are invited from students seeking financial support of the fund. The application should be submitted to the office of Principal by the date stipulated by the College authority. A committee or the G.B. of the College will verify the application and select name of the beneficiaries.

GAMES & SPORTS

All kinds of encouragement and opportunities are provided by the College to the students to develop their competence in Games & Sports like Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Badminton, Carrom, Chess etc.

SCHOLARSHIP

The College provides a number of Scholarships to the students as,

- a) Merit Scholarship
- b) Scholarship to the students from SC, ST and OBC categories.
- c) Scholarship to the students from Minority Communities.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR

Various departments organise educational tour to different parts of N.E. India. However, a compulsory tour of 'Environmental Studies' for the students of 4th Semester is organised under the guidance of Nodal Teacher.

The College Library is a learning resource center for the students. At present, it has a collection about 5400 books including text books, general books and reference books covering subjects. The library subscribes journals and newspapers for updating knowledge. The students are facilitated to make Xerox on payment. Maintaining peace and silence is indicative in using the resources in the library. Besides, students are provided with Wi-fi facilities in the library.

COLLEGE IQAC

The College has an "Internal Quality Assurance Cell" (IQAC). The IQAC is a quality concern Cell that monitors the quality of matter glucoses. The IQAC was established in the year 2013 as per the direction of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).

KKHSOU STUDY CENTRE

Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University Study Center (KKHSOU) starts in the College in the year 2007. At present, the study center has been imparting education about 150 learners. Those who are seeking to get admitted can contact to Co-ordinator of the study center Contact No. +919864285802.

D.El.Ed. STUDY CENTRE

Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) Study Centre under NIOS starts in the College in 2018. It has been counselling more than 200 trainees to prepare them as quality teacher in elementary level.

SUPPORT SERVICES

- **Women Cell:** The "Women Cell" of the College facilitates a gender-sensitive and pleasant working environment in and outside the college campus. It takes up various issues related to the empowerment of the girls' students, women in the present context, by organizing various discussions, seminars, debates etc.
- **Environmental & Social responsibilities Cell:** The existing Environmental and social responsibilities Cell of the College is taking various positive initiatives in the respective direction by organizing environmental awareness camp, seminars, plantation program etc. this very cell especially aims at making green environment of the College and its surroundings.
- **Student Counseling & Placement Cell:** There is a student counseling and placement cell in the College whose main motto is to guide and assist the student's individually or collectively for academic career and social-economic guidance. Also, this cell is liable to provide job assuring training courses in association with the College for creating employable human resources.
- **Anti Ragging Cell:** The College follows a policy of zero tolerance against substance abuse and ragging. Any student, if found in possession of banned substances like ghutka, drugs, alcohol etc. and indulging in ragging, strict disciplinary action may be taken on them. There is a six member committee to monitor various anti ragging measures.

There are some other Organizations/Cells in the College like NCC Unit, NSS Unit, Alumni Association, Academic Unit etc. for the all-round development of the students.

THE STUDENTS' UNION

There is a Students' Union in the College which is an elected body of the students. Generally, the election to the Students' Union is held every year during the month of September to October as per the guidelines. The Students' Union, organizes some annual events like the Freshmen Social, Annual College Week etc. for which College authority provides all kinds of assistance.

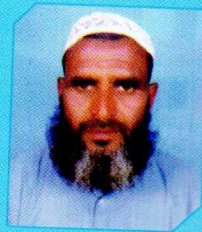

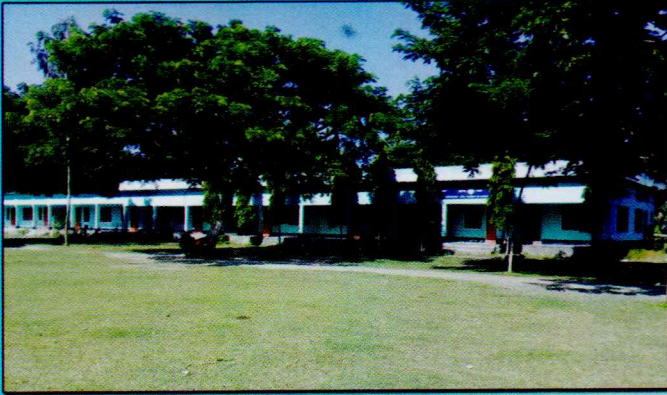
