
Departmental Seminars:

In 2017

On 4th March, 2017 a seminar was organized by the Department of Economics on the topic ***“Issues and Challenges of Indian Economy”***. The Seminar was chaired by Md. Field Study cum Educational Tour

In 2017

On 11th of April of 2017, the teachers and the students of the Department of Economics visited the *Shillong* of Meghalaya. All the students from Honours and Non- Honours Courses and all the teachers (three) from the Department visited the town to conduct a socio- economic survey of the town. The survey found that the inhabitants of the town are from Different castes and Communities. Meghalaya basically agro- based state and 80% of its population are depending on agriculture for their livelihood. Nearly 10% of geographical area is under agriculture. The people of the town are from different religions such as Hindus are 41.95%, Muslims are 4.89%, Christians are 46.49%, Sikhs are 1.14%, and Jains are 0.13%.



In 2018

On 5th of February in 2018, the teachers and the students of the Department of Economics visited the site *Cherapunji*, situated in Meghalaya. The students (both from Major and General Course) and all the teachers (three) from the Department visited the site with a view to conduct a socio-

economic survey. Cherapunji is the place of Meghalaya, where highest rain falls in the world. The people of this place are mainly Tribal. Their livelihood is mainly agriculture and forest- based activities.

In 2019

On 5th of February, 2019, a group of students along with two teachers from the Department of Economics, F. A. Ahmed College visited site "**Bhairab Kunda**". The site is situated in Darrang district of Assam. It is on the border of Arunachal Pradesh and Bhutan. The Bhairabi river and Jampani river, which originate in Bhutan merges here to form river Dhanshiri and forms a lovely view to behold. People prominently considered the place as a suitable picnic spot for the new year. The Hindus devotees visit the place in "Makar Sankranti" where they take bath in the meeting point of three rivers and offer pujas in the shiva temple. According to proverbial tales there was a kunda where the devotees used to offer pujas.

In 2020

On 29th November of 2020, the students of Economics department along with the teachers of the said department visited a site of *Khetrapara Char* in the district of Kamrup, Assam. This Char is dominated by the minority Muslim people and their main occupation is agriculture. This people have been straggling with the river Brahmaputra year after year. The main cultivation of these people is agriculture. Rice, jute and mesta, chillies, various vegetables are the main products of these people. Recently maize is producing extensively as cash crops. There are few primary schools in this char and the literacy rate of this place is very low. There is river erosion and

frequently have to shift their houses from one char to another char and thus they have been straggling with the nature.



In 2021

On 24 Of February the students of Economics department along with the teachers of the department visited the site “*Manas*” of Baksa district of Assam. The site is located in Chirang and Baksa district of BTR, Assam. It is a national park, Project Tiger reserve, biosphere reserve and an

elephant reserve in Assam, India. Manas situated on the bank of river mans at the foothills of the Himalayas. The beautiful park earlier known as North- Kamrup wildlife sanctuary is spread over an area of 519.77 sq km and was declared a a sanctuary on December01, 1928. It was established as the core of the Manas Tiger Reserve from April, 1973. The park is known for its rare and endangered endemic wildlife such as roofed turtle, hispid hare, golden langur and pygmy hog. Manas is famous for its population of the wild water buffalo.



In 2022

On 6th Of February/2022, the department of Economics visited the site Borapani of, Meghalaya as Educational Tour along with the students of the department of History and Hindi. The students learnt a lot about the natural site of Borapani, especially enjoyed the authentic beauty of the Lake there. They also become familiar with the cultural heritage of the people of their locality.
