## Concept Notes:

Agriculture is the oldest and most important source of livelihood of mankind. The history of human civilisation reveals that agriculture had transformed human life style from nomadic to the present society. When human being shifted from hunting to an agrarian way of life, human society got changed forever. The progress of mankind had been closely associated with plantation and harvesting of crops. As they started to settle in a particular place and grew plants for food, it irreversibly had changed their living. Production of crops and domestication of animals initiated the stage of human civilisation. Working in the field of agriculture for food was the beginning of human civilisation.

Literally, the meaning of agriculture is the 'tillage of soil or fields' for extracting human needs. Agriculture had been associated with the production of crops for long. Now a day, coverage of agriculture is no longer confined with the production of crops alone, but its allied activities have also been incorporated with it. Besides production of crops, it horizontally covers forestry, horticulture, fruit cultivation, mushroom, dairy, fishery, bee keeping, arboriculture and animal husbandry and vertically covers marketing, processing and distribution of agricultural products. The scope of agriculture has widened up to the extent that it even takes into account some off farm activities like supply of agro-inputs i.e., fertilizer, pesticides, credit, insurance, veterinary services etc.

Livestock sector is an important and integral part of the mixed-farming system that can be characterized by agriculture. Besides contributing to food and crop production, livestock and poultry, fish cultivation are now days very important and convenient source of rural savings.

Agriculture is the backbone of the Indian economy playing the most decisive role in the Socio-economic development of the country. It is the largest sector absorbing country's population whereas more than half of the Indian population are directly or indirectly dependent on it.

Assam is one of the backward states in the country basically dependent on this particular sector. According to Statistical Handbook, Assam 2011, as much as 99 per cent of the total land mass of the state belongs to rural areas, and 86% of the state population are dwelling in the rural areas majority of whom are directly or indirectly dependent on this particular sector. Because of the suitable agro-climatic condition with good fertile lands, the state has immense scope for enhancing farm output and agribusiness.

The Brahmaputra is the biggest river that bifurcates the state Assam from east to west. Along with its meandering journey, it gives birth of numerous braided channels or river island which is known as Char or Chapori which is conducive for agriculture. Such riverine areas has been the core part of rural Assam purely dependent on agriculture which is of traditional in nature. However, recurring flood and river erosion are the experiences affecting the livelihood pattern of the cultivating people of the state in general and char people in particular. Flood causes damage of standing crops and also harms and washes away the livestock especially during the over flood period. Therefore, both the manaces often make the people landless as well as homeless which push such people in the grievance of poverty.

In spite of hard labouring of rural farmers in the field of agriculture, majority of them are economically poor and deprived from the basic necessities of life. Even after 60 years of economic planning, majority of rural population remain under the grip of poverty because agriculture in these areas is still characterized as orthodox farming. It is fully depending on gamble of monsoon and consequently agricultural production in the area is not stable and unpredictable. As the agricultural economy is the basic foundation of Assam, a sincere approach may be undertaken to improve the agriculture sector by modernization which will raise the income of rural people and offer job opportunity to them.

Thus, the conditions of the agriculture of the state need to be studied and addressed. Such type of study is sure to be effective for the policy makers to prepare the development strategies for the state as well as for the vulnerable sections of the rural people.
